CONVERSATIONS:

- What do you think of when you think about wrath? Where did you get your picture of "wrath" from?
- Why do you think Paul begins his explanation of the gospel with such intense and challenging language?
- How would you explain the "wrath of God" to a new or non-Christian person?
 Read Romans 1:18-23. In this passage Paul lists 4 reasons for God's wrath.
 - 1. The suppression of the truth (v. 18). Why do we suppress the truth?
 - 2. Ignoring the revelation of God. (vv. 19 20). What are some examples
 from the world around you that reveal to you the existence of God?
 - o 3. Entitlement (v. 21). What is the entitlement that this verse is talking about?
 - 4. They exchanged the truth for a lie (vv. 22 23). Where do you see the truth being exchanged for a lie...
 - In our culture?
 - In yourself?



- In this verse Paul describes some idols. In our culture we don't worship physical idols. Instead our idols are typically "good things that we've made ultimate things." What kinds of things do you see as potential idols?
- Read Romans 1:24 27.
 - C.S. Lewis once wrote: "There are only two kinds of people in the end: those who say to God, 'Thy will be done,' and those to whom God says, in the end, 'Thy will be done.' How is this a description of God's wrath?
 - Paul uses sexual brokenness to demonstrate how our broken identities
 lead to a search for identity and pleasure where it can't be found.
 - Why do you think sexuality is often the place people search for identity?
 - How can we love our LGBTQ+ neighbors?
- Read Romans 1:28-32
 - Which parts of the list of corrupted thoughts and actions do you see most present in the world around you?
 - O What about within yourself?
- How can we battle sin without falling into a gospel of works instead of the gospel of grace?
